## 2018 COACHING POSITIONS

Avoca Beach Rugby Club is inviting Expressions of Interest from people wishing to be considered for coaching positions in the 2018 season. Please forward responses to avocasharks@gmail.com

- Club Coach The Club coach is also 1<sup>st</sup> Grade Coach and has ultimate responsibility for maintaining coaching standards throughout the Club. Applicants should hold ARU Level 2 coaching qualifications, or be prepared to attain that qualification at the first available opportunity.
- 2. Senior coaches For the 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade and u19 Colts teams, under the direction of the Club Coach. Applicants should have completed the ARU Foundation (Level 1) coaching course or be prepared to complete that course at the first available opportunity.
- 3. Womens 7s coach(es) There is the possibility CCRU will conduct a competition for womens 7s in 2018. Applicants should have completed the ARU Senior Sevens course or be prepared to complete that course at the first available opportunity
- 4. Junior Coaching Co-Ordinator Oversee all aspects of Junior coaching at the Club. Applicants should hold ARU Level 2 coaching qualification, or be prepared to attain that qualification at the first available opportunity.
- 5. Junior (u19 Law) coaches For ages from u13 to u17. Applicants should have completed the ARU Foundation (Level 1) Coaching course or be prepared to complete that course at the first available opportunity.
- 6. Girls 7s coaches CCJRU successfully trialled girls 7s at the completion of the 2017 season and will be working to providing formal competitions in 2018. Age groups have not been finalised, but there probably will be three age groups for girls older than u12s. Applicants should have completed the ARU Junior Sevens course or be prepared to complete that course at the first available opportunity.
- 7. Junior (Pathways) coaches For ages u7 to u12. Usually multiple teams in u7-u9 age groups and single teams in u10-u12 age groups. All applicants should have completed the ARU Coaching Kids Rugby course or be prepared to complete that course at the first available opportunity.
